Keynote Presentation Eminent Domain Trial Practice

The Honorable Ronald Evans Quidachay, Judge

Superior Court of San Francisco

Ronald Evans Quidachay is a Judge for the Superior Court of San Francisco in California. He was appointed to the San Francisco Municipal Court in 1983 by Governor Jerry Brown, and was elevated to the Superior Court upon court unification in 1998. In 2010, he was re-elected to a six-year term, which will expire on January 1, 2017. Judge Quidachay received his bachelor's degree from San Francisco State University and his law degree from the University of California, Berkeley Boalt Hall School of Law. Prior to being appointed to the bench, he practiced law with the San Francisco Neighborhood Legal Assistance Foundation, the San Francisco City Attorney's Office, and the law firm of Lenvin, Gesmer & Quidachay.
